All site staff are trained to a high standard including, but not limited to ATEX, IPAF, PASMA and confined spaces. Site Managers are required to have a minimum qualification of SMSTS or equivalent.

Marches Biogas's system of reporting positive interventions is continually improving, with staff embracing a positive health and safety culture, focused on continual improvement and welcome constructive input from our staff and third parties.
